THE FIAAC GOES 3D!

After a decade of focusing on painting, the FIAAC en Pouilly Fumé is adding a new dimension–sculpture! Sculptors as well as painters are therefore invited to submit their applications **before 1 December 223.** Also new in 2024, the FIAAC will take place a week later than previously–from **8 to 12 May, inclusive.**

Artists will exhibit their work for **5 days** in the wine cellars of the vintners who selected them. These large, individual exhibitions are held in spacious sites that range from ultra-modern to traditional, and in all cases show the work off to advantage. That's just one of the reasons our visitor count has increased every year since 2013 and the FIAAC has become a must for wine and art lovers alike to add to their collections!

ORGANIZATION

The artists' files are reviewed by a committee of **art specialists** and the officers of our non-profit organization. Their criteria are the originality, consistency, and of course the quality of the works. At the same time, based on the works alone, each vintner chooses the artist they would like to have exhibit in their wine cellar. The artists who are selected will be informed in **early January 2024.** A catalogue is printed every year presenting each artist and their host. The FIAAC also has its own website and is publicized locally and throughout France.

The works will be installed on 7 May 2024. Picture rails and lighting are provided by each vintner, who also provides **free accommodation for their artist** and a guest. The artists are responsible for transporting and insuring their works. They are free to set their prices and pay no commission on their sales. Together, the artists and vintners welcome visitors during opening hours. On Saturday 11 May, a jury of people well known in the French art world will award **the Grand Prix de la FIAAC en Pouilly Fumé** to one of the artists, and the **Zeuxis Prize** to the best exhibition (artist + vintner). The artists will award the **Dionysos Prize** to one of the participating vintners. All additional information will be sent to the selected artists by the organizing committee and the artists' vintner/gallerists.
